

THE CORPORATION OF THE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT OF DUBREUILVILLE  
BY-LAW NO. 86-30

A By-Law to control and regulate residents owning and using bicycles on the Highways.


WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to prohibit the acts hereinafter set forth pursuant to the powers granted under the Municipal Act;

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Improvement District of Dubreuilville

ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. No person resident of the Improvement District of Dubreuilville owning or using a bicycle shall use the same upon any highway of the Improvement District of Dubreuilville between the period of November 1st and April 15th of any year unless the said highways are completely clear of snow during period aforementioned.
2. Every person guilty of a breach of any provisions of this by-law shall forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting magistrate a penalty not exceeding (exclusive costs) the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$ 50.00) for each offence which penalty may be recoverable in the manner provided by the Municipal Act.
3. That this By-Law shall take effect upon the approval of the Ministry of Municipal Affairs-Sudbury Field Office.
